



★ KINKY CARROT ★

SKILL LEVEL :

★☆☆ Beginner

To make this pattern you will need to know how to :

begin with a magic ring ● single crochet ● increase ●
 invisible decrease ● switch color ● work in back loops only
 ● work in continuous rounds

GAUGE AND FINISHED SIZE :

Gauge is not essential for this project : you can use any size of hook you want as long as your yarn choice is consistent with it. Just be careful to work tight stitches so as the stuffing doesn't show through.

As an indication : I used a 3.00 mm hook and my toy ended 22cm high.



The bigger hook size you'll choose, the bigger your Amigurumi will be !

SUPPLIES :

- * Yarn :
 - Orange,
 - Green,
 - Black (small amount)
 - Brown (small amount)
- * Black embroidery thread
- * Crafting felt sheets (small amount needed) :
 - Black,
 - White,
 - Red
- * Crochet hook
- * Tapestry needle
- * Stuffing material (fiberfill)
- * Pins
- * Scissors
- * Brass wire
- * Zinc-coated wire : approximately 1,50m.
- * Jewelry pliers :
 - Round nose
 - Flat nose
 - Cutter
- * Strong Crafting Glue



ABBREVIATIONS :

- R : round
 MR : magic ring
 st(s) : stitch(es)
 slst(s) : slip stitch(es)
 sc : single crochet
 inc : increase (= single crochet 2 stitches in same sc)
 dec : decrease (= single crochet 2 stitches in front loops together)
 BLO : back loops only
 FO : fasten off
 * ...* x... : repeat instructions between * * as many times as indicated

ARMS :

(make 2 using orange yarn)

- R1 : MR 6
 R2 : *inc, sc* x3 (9)
 R3 : sc around (9)
 R4 : *dec,sc*x3 (6)
 R5 - 24 : sc around (6)

Slst in next stitch, FO, leave long tail for sewing.



FINGERS :

(make 2 using orange yarn and brass wire)

- R1 : Sc 3 around wire, chain 1, turn (3)
 R2 : skip 1st stitch from hook, sc in next 3 (3)
 R3 : Sc 3 around wire, chain 1, turn (3)
 R4 : skip 1st stitch from hook, sc in next 3 (3)
 R5 : Sc 3 around wire, chain 1, turn (3)
 R6 : skip 1st stitch from hook, sc in next 3 (3)

Arrange fingers and place it on the hand. Pull the loop and the end of wire 2 rounds further, and make the thumb :

- R7 : Sc 3 around wire, chain 1, turn (3)
 R8 : slip 1st stitch from hook, sc in next 3 (3)

Slst, leave long tail to sew fingers in place.

Hide wire ends inside the arm.



LEGS :

(make 2 using orange and black yarn)

- R1 : MR 3
 R2 : inc, sc2 (4)
 R3 : sc around (4)
 R4 : inc, sc3 (5)



R5 : sc around (5)
 R6 : inc, sc4 (6)
 R7 : sc around (6)
 R8 : inc, sc5 (7)
 R9 : sc around (7)
 R10 : inc, sc6 (8)
 R11 : sc around (8)
 R12 : inc, sc7 (9)
 R13 : sc around (9)
 R14 : inc, sc8 (10)
 R15 : sc around (10)
 R16 : inc, sc9 (11)
 R17 : sc around (11)
 R18 : inc, sc10 (12)
 R19 : sc around (12)
 R20 : inc, sc11 (13)
 R21 : sc around (13)
 R22 : inc, sc12 (14)



R23 : *change color to black yarn*, slst around (14)
 R24 : sc around BLO (14)

R25 : *change color to orange yarn*, slst BLO twice in first sc, then slst BLO around (15)
 R26 : sc around BLO (15)
 R27 : sc around (15)

*First leg : Slst in next stitch, FO and weave in ends.
 Second leg : do not slst nor cut yarn.*

Continue with the Head/body part :



HEAD/BODY :

(using orange yarn)

R28 : Join legs by working one sc in the last sc of first leg, then sc all around (30)
 R29 : sc8, inc in the next 4 sts, sc 6, inc in the next 4sts, sc8 (38)
 R30 : sc10, inc, sc2, inc, sc4, slst2, sc4, inc, sc2, inc, sc10 (42)



R31 : sc 19, dec, dec, sc 19 (40)
 R32 : sc 16, dec in the next 8 sts, sc 16 (36)
 R33 : sc 16, dec in the next 4 sts, sc 16 (34)
 R34 : sc 13, dec in the next 8 sts, sc 13 (30)
 R35 : sc ar (30)

Make a few stitches with a tapestry needle and orange yarn to shape the buttocks.

Take a 70 cm piece of wire.

Fold it in half, then again on both side, 10 cm from center (this will go in the legs). Attach wire ends in the middle. Insert wire structure in the legs and begin stuffing at the same time.

Then, continue stuffing as you go with the following rounds :

R36 : sc 11, dec 4 times, sc 13, move stitch marker (26)
 R37 : sc 6, inc, sc 12, inc, sc 6 (28)
 R38 : sc 9, inc, sc 8, inc, sc 9 (30)
 R39 : *sc 4, inc* x6 (36)
 R40 - 43 : sc around (36)
 R44 : *sc 5, inc* x6 (42)
 R45 - 53 : sc around (42)
 R54 : *dec, sc 5* x6 (36)
 R55 : *dec, sc 4* x6 (30)
 R56 - 57 : sc around (30)

Take a 45 cm piece of wire.

Make a little loop to go in the hand, and insert it in the arm. Insert the other end of wire between rounds 49 & 50. Sew arm in place. Use the other arm to adjust the length of wire, make another loop to go in the hand, insert wire in the arm and sew arm on body.

Then, continue stuffing as you go with the following rounds :

R58 : *dec, sc 3* x6 (24)
 R59 : *dec, sc 2* x6 (18)
 R60 : *dec, sc* x6 (12)
 R61 : dec around (6)

FO , weave in ends



BOOBS :

(make 2 using orange yarn)

R1 : MR 6

R2 : inc around (12)

R3 - 4 : sc around (12)

FO and keep a long tail for sewing on head.



BASE OF HAIR :

R1 : MR 6

R2 : *inc, sc* x3 (9)

Slt in next stitch, FO, leave long tail and sew on top of the head.



HAIR :

*Cut 10 cm of bright green yarn.
Fold it in half to create a loop, pull it through 2 stitches holes.*



Pull ends through the loop to block the thread.



*Repeat as many times as necessary to have a nice volume.
Brush the yarn to create the hair effect.
Trim to shape the Mohawk.*



FISHNET :

Begin at the base of the leg, embroidering a cross with black thread.

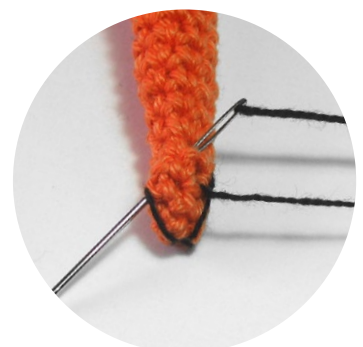
To start a new round, pull the needle out a little above between two stitches.



Then, pull the needle under the next stitch without going in.



Again, take the needle in a little above between the 2 next stitches and pull it out on the second one.



While blocking this stitch, take the needle in once more in this same stitch and pull it out in the previous one.



Now you've completed the first «V» of the second row. Proceed the same all around.



To start the third row, take the needle in a little above between 2 stitches, and repeat same procedure.



Keep going all the way up, and you're done !



THONG :

Cut a large triangle out of paper and place it on your doll to adjust the size. Make the edges curvier, and when you're happy with your pattern, use it to cut your shape out of black felt.



Embroider back of thong with black yarn and tapestry needle.



FACE :

Cut out two 7mm diameter circles in black felt and two 4mm diameter circles in white felt.

(Tip : use hole punches to have neat shapes !)



Use this shape to cut out mouth in black felt :*



Use this shape to cut out tongue in red felt :*



** Scale if needed*

NIPPIES :

Cut two stars out of black felt and glue them on the boobs.
